- Disabled children and young people
- Children and young people with special educational needs. (Special educational needs are when you need a little extra help to learn things).
- Families of those children and young people

- Schools, colleges, or training
- Special health support
- Fun activities that are happening and competitions
- Support for becoming an adult
- Transport
- How you will be assessed to see what support you need

- It is written by your local authority, which might be called 'the council'.
- Every local council will have its own local offer. It will be different in every area.
- If you do not have access to the internet, you can ask your local council for information that is in leaflet form.



You can have your say about what is in the local offer.

- It must show everyone what people have said and explain how the council are going to make it better.
- The council must ask you what should be included in the Local Offer. You can share your thoughts with the local authority about it.
